This fall has been an eventful season for the Westmont campus and its school community. The school year started off well, and the activities program went straight to work on preparing spirit activities for an earlier than usual homecoming week. Our ASB leadership students did a great job putting together the events of that week, and demonstrated the school's spirit to a packed main gym of students, parents, and alumni. The week concluded with a Homecoming victory over Prospect High School and the Homecoming dance.

With the fall sports season wrapped up and the winter sports season now ramping up, I want to thank the coaches, students, volunteers and sports boosters of all seasons for their energy, time and commitment throughout the year. Their efforts make our sports program shine. Particular congratulations go to our undefeated Girls Volleyball team who made it to CCS finals after an undefeated regular season. Girls Field Hockey and Tennis also found their places in CCS playoffs, as well as members of the Cross Country team. Our competition Cheer program has also earned their way Nationals and will be competing for a 1st place title in February.



The music and drama programs have had tremendous starts to their years. Westmont's Marching Band program has had a successful competition season and the Music Department's winter concert is just around the corner. The Drama Department kicked off their year with successful productions of Shakespeare's *Twelfth Night*, *Just Add Zombies*, and their annual Haunted House fundraiser. They are now in production of their winter comedy *Bullshot Crummond*. I encourage you all to take advantage of and experience the work our students and staff put into Westmont's incredible performing arts programs.

Construction will soon be underway for the renovations of the library complex. The renovations will bring nearly 90% more library space for students to access, and will be the home of the new Student Services Center. These renovations will also include a complete overhaul of electrical, plumbing, heating and air conditioning systems as well as upgrades to technology throughout. These completion of this project is scheduled for opening the school year in fall of 2012. While undergoing these renovations, the front driveway near the main office will be closed to traffic. The driveway area will be reserved for contractor access and vehicles beginning in January.

The underground electrical infrastructure is being set up now in preparation for the placement of the solar parking structures in March 2012. Once these solar paneled structures come online (slated for May of 2012), we should be serving approximately 80% of our current electrical usage needs, which translates to an enormous savings in energy costs each year. The school bond measures for the Campbell Union High School District our community supported have made possible these vital upgrades to the school a reality. Generations of students have truly been the benefactors of our community's generosity.

## DEAN'S CORNER

The Deans are concerned about the large number of cars dropping off and especially picking up students after school. Since the turnaround in front of the school is usually coned-off, cars are often double- and triple-parked in front of the school along Westmont Avenue. This is not only illegal but poses a very dangerous situation for our students and others. The Deans recommend that drivers use the "bus chute" entry and drop-off area in front of the Performing Arts Center (PAC). From Westmont Avenue, turn into the PAC driveway, then follow the arrows around and through the bus chute. Parents and students will find this a safer alternative than crowding the front of the school along Westmont Avenue and drivers will avoid getting a ticket from local law enforcement.



Now that the weather is turning more severe, visibility will become harder, especially on rainy and foggy days. The administration, as always, is concerned about safety in and around our school. Please use caution when called for during these days of inclement weather. Thank you for your consideration and have a wonderful and safe holiday season!
