

Juntos Podemos (Latino Parent Group)

A parent led and school supported organization that meets once a month and acts as the liaison between WHS and the Latino community of students and parents. The leader of this group plans events throughout the year for the Latino community and works with PTSA to advertise events and opportunities to both parents and students. Leader attends the general PTSA meetings to provide status of the group activities, request assistance when needed and shares information. Communicates volunteer opportunities and notices of events to the Latino community. Work with school guidance counselors and administration to arrange communication programs. Assist in getting information out to parents and students and helping with Registration and College planning. This group needs bi-lingual members to fill the following roles:

Group Leader and Co-leader = To lead the organization towards its established goals; organize and hold meetings with other officers to plan activities, meetings and fundraisers; continuous recruitment and maintenance of parent members; liaison with school administration.

Secretary = Record meeting minutes; reads summary of minute from prior meetings; keeps records, maintains and updates flyers, agenda, marketing materials, meeting initiations, etc; responsible for the communication committee.

Treasurer = Keeps track of and reports all financial records; responsible for fundraising and purchasing materials, food, etc. needed for the meetings and events; responsible for the fundraising committee. This position is required to work closely with the PTSA Treasurer and abide by PTSA treasurer policies.

Fundraising Committee = Two members, responsible for group events, meetings and student scholarships.

Student Recognition & College and Career Center Liaison = Organizes student achievement recognition; coordinate with the college and career center to provide information to members and their students.

Committee Members = 10 members, each of the 10 committee members would be responsible for the communication with approximately 15 parent members; responsible for calling their group of parents to invite them to meetings and events.
