Westmont High School PTSA Graduating Senior Scholarship 2010

AVAILABILITY

The Westmont PTSA will offer Westmont High School Graduating Senior Scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each to acknowledge academic achievement and volunteer service in the school and community. Applicants must be Westmont High School Seniors, graduating from Westmont on June 10, 2010. A minimum of 6 senior students will receive scholarships.

Scholarship is to be used during fall semester/quarter following high school graduation at an accredited* college or university, community college or trade or technical school.

The applicant minimum criteria are as follows (must meet all for consideration):

1. A minimum four year academic weighted GPA of 2.0 or greater.
2. Participation in a minimum of one community service activity during each of the Junior and Senior year (verification by references is required).
3. References are to be completed by a community volunteer leader or teacher with whom student applicant has served.
4. Application will not be considered if received after due date or if any of the required materials are missing.
5. Reference forms, completed application, copy of your high school transcript, and proof of enrollment or equivalent to a University, State, Junior College, Vocational or Trade School must be placed in a sealed envelope and **turned in to the PTSA box in the Westmont High School Main Office no later than 2:30 PM on May 28, 2010.**

QUALIFICATIONS

Scholarships will focus on academic & community service achievement. Award recipients must present proof of enrollment in college or vocational school in order to receive their award. Award recipients will be announced at the Senior Awards night on June 7, 2010.

SELECTION

Recipients are selected by the Westmont High School PTSA Scholarship Committee. All applicants will be notified of their standing by June 4, 2010. A check for the scholarship will be sent directly to the recipient's home address.

* Accreditation acceptable from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, Inc., Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, New England Association of Schools and Colleges, North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, Northwest Association of Schools and colleges and Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.
