California High School Exit Exam — CAHSEE — 8:00 AM March 11th and 12th, 2008

On March 11th and 12th, Westmont will administer the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) to ALL sophomore students for their first time. Every student must pass both sections, English and Math, to graduate. Results will be available before the summer and scores will be mailed to parents/guardians. If students do not pass, they will have opportunities to retake it again next year. All sophomore students need to come to school by 8:00 AM both Tuesday, March 11th A-day and Wednesday March 12th B-day.

All freshmen, juniors and seniors will have late start days on March 11th and 12th starting at 10:30 AM to allow for a quiet testing environment for our sophomore class. Classes will end at 2:15 PM except for period 4 or 8. There will be no zero period or tutorial on March 11th or 12th. We are asking that all students who are not testing arrive on campus at 10:15 AM to begin their classes at 10:30 AM. Thank you.

They are a scam.* Even if you think you don't qualify for financial aid, **apply** and **let them decide**. You may qualify for assistance!
