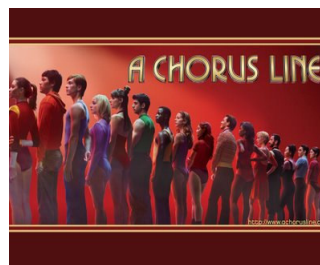
From the Desk of...MATT KOLDA

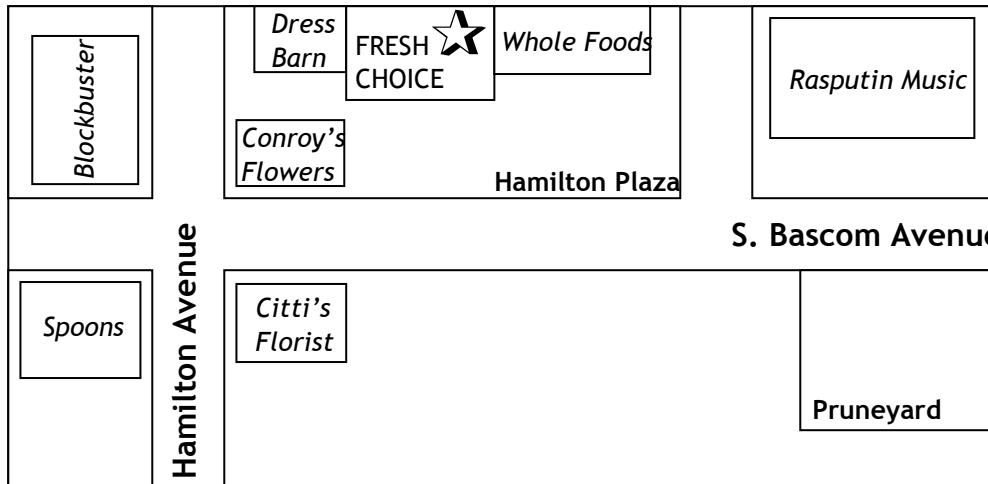

California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) — 8:00 AM March 17th and 18th, 2009

On March 17th and 18th, Westmont will administer the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) to ALL sophomore students for their first time. Every student must pass both sections, English and Math, to graduate. Results will be available before the summer and scores will be mailed to parents/guardians. If students do not pass, they will have opportunities to retake it again next year. All sophomore students need to come to school by 8:00 AM both Tuesday, March 17th B-day and Wednesday March 18th A-day.

All freshmen, juniors and seniors will have late start days on March 17th and 18th starting at 10:30 AM to allow for a quiet testing environment for our sophomore class. Classes will end at 2:15 PM except for period 4 or 8. There will be no zero period or tutorial on March 17th or 18th. We are asking that all students who are not testing arrive on campus at 10:15 AM to begin their classes at 10:30 AM. Thank you.

SENIORS, IT'S FINANCIAL AID TIME ... *What do you need to do?*

1. Fill out the FAFSA application before March 2nd (the earlier the better)
2. Fill out the Cal Grant GPA Release Form – turn it in to your counselor by Feb. 13th

Find the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application at: www.fafsa.ed.gov. Even if you think you don't qualify for financial aid, apply and let them decide.
